Tuition & Enrollment Information



Annual Registration Fees:

\$30 New Student Registration Fee
\$25 Renewal Registration Fee
\$15 Renewal for current ISI members
Registration fee includes ISI membership.
ISI members must show active membership card to receive discounted renewal fee.

Class Fees:

\$150 per Session for 30-minute Classes
\$175 per Session for 45-minute Classes
\$200 per Session for 60-minute Classes
\$187.50 for 10-week synchronized teams &
\$450 for 6-month teams
10% Discount on multiple enrollments applies to lesser enrollment, some restrictions apply

Discounts:

10% Discount on additional class enrollments
10% Discount on additional family members
\$10 Early Re-enrollment Discount
★ 2 weeks prior to start of semester
\$5 Early Re-enrollment Discount
★ 1 week prior to start of semester

Individual Class Fees:

\$20 Drop-In Fee for 30- and 45-minute Classes
\$25 Drop-In Fee for 60-minute Classes
No refunds on any drop-in class fees.
Drop-ins may be denied in full classes.

Trial Classes:

\$10 Trial Class Fee for beginner classes
First-time students only. No refunds on any trial classes. \$10 fee applied to registration if skater enrolls.

Checking In for Class:

Participants must always check in at the front desk or box office to receive an admission sticker. This sticker must be presented at the skate counter to obtain rental skates and must be worn and visible at all times on the ice.

Make up Lessons:

Participants are allowed up to a maximum of 3 make up lessons for missed classes. Make up lessons must be scheduled in advance with the front desk or the Skating Academy Director. Make up lessons may not be taken in full classes. Make up lessons must be attended during the enrolled semester only and will not carry over into future semesters. No credit or refund is offered for unused or missed classes.

Cancellations/Refunds/Credit Policy:

Classes with less than 3 students may be canceled or combined. For all refund requests, a completed "Refund Request Form" must be received by the Skating Academy Director by the end of the third (3rd) week of the enrolled semester. Enrollment card and any unused vouchers must be attached to the form. A \$10 cancellation fee plus the cost of any regularly scheduled classes taught prior to the refund request (whether attended or not) and any used public session vouchers will be deducted from the refund amount. Refund requests submitted after the 3rd week of classes will be accepted for medical reasons only, must have a doctor's note attached and are subject to management discretion. No credits, refunds make-ups or discounts for drop-ins and trial classes. Annual registration fees are non-refundable. Vouchers have no cash value and are non-refundable and non-replaceable, no exceptions. Fees and enrollments are non-transferable.
